Chenghuang Temple: Chenghuang, guardian of the city, is the protector and a central belief in the lives of Chiayi City residents. Chenghuang has been closely connected to the lives of people since ancient times and is deemed the most popular deity in the area. Built in 1715 during the Qing dynasty and has a rich history of over 300 years. The grand and elegant style is decorated by the highest skill of woodcarving masters, and the octagon ceiling well, hallway, and brackets of the side-wings were built by joints without using a single nail. The craftsmanship was the peak of contemporary technology. **Hinoki Village:** It is the earliest forestry village in Taiwan, as well as the only wood-structure buildings settlement being preserved. The area spans about 3.4 hectares and is divided into north and south Linsen Road area. The south of area was a Japanese official residences of senior officials, and the north area was the grassroots staff dormitories. It is the first cultural and creative forest park, and is the largest Japanese-style buildings in Taiwan. We offer you a creative leisure place of cultural value and creativity.
