1	<p>新加坡  东京</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>集合在新加坡国际机场乘搭豪华客机，飞往日出之国 - 日本。</li> </ul>	
2	<p><b>东京/函馆/五棱郭/函馆山夜景</b></p> <p>抵达后，由当地代表迎接，开始游览。</p> <p>函馆五棱郭是江户时代末期开放后，为加强对外国的防卫能力和准备外国船来航而建造的要塞，采用法国筑城方式，呈五棱星形。</p> <p>特别安排搭乘高速空中缆车参观函馆山夜景，每当华灯初上之际，市内密密麻麻白黄的灯光，就仿如一盆美钻摆在面前，景致迷人被称为世界三大名夜景之一。</p> <p>注：如遇空中缆车故障或临时维修保养时，则改搭乘专车上山，欣赏百万夜景。</p>	晚餐
3	<p><b>函馆/朝市/金森红砖仓库/大沼公园/昭和新山/登别</b></p> <p>参观函馆传统朝市，北海道三大传统市场之一（函馆朝市，札幌二条市场，钏路和商市场），除了可深入了解北国风情，您也可自费品尝新鲜生海胆。</p> <p>金森红砖仓库原是为作为仓库使用的红砖建筑群，现在则是集中了餐馆，商店，美术馆，展会厅等的商业设施。</p> <p>活火山驹岳和大沼，小沼等大小湖沼群的一带统称为大沼，于1958年被指定为国定公园。这些湖是大约500年前驹岳喷发时的火山泥流截断溪流而形成的。</p> <p>湖岸近处有昭和新山，这是1943年在地震造成的断层处而隆起的一块新地形，至今还在喷发白烟。这里是北海道为数不多的温泉胜地。游览活火山昭和新山并在那拍照留念。</p> <p>接着，前往具有代表性的温泉区 - 温泉度假村，夜宿登别温泉度假村，在这里尝试穿上日本夏季和服，品尝晚餐和浸泡道地温泉。</p>	早餐 午餐 晚餐
4	<p><b>登别/白老爱奴民/地狱谷/小樽/小樽运河/北一硝子馆/札幌</b></p> <p>白老爱奴民族村参观，了解北海道爱奴民族的传统文化和生活型态。亲身体验一下传统日本人的生活习惯，并且寻古探幽一番。</p> <p>您将游览著名的“地狱谷”火山口的熔岩与硫磺喷泉的奇景。这里您也会体验到一股热气从地底喷出来，可说是一种说不出的新鲜感。</p> <p>小樽是位于札幌市西北的港口城镇。保留着数目众多的石砌西洋建筑及古式日本建筑等历史久远的建筑物。</p>	早餐 午餐

6	<p><b>旭川/美瑛/富良野/札幌</b></p> <p>位于美瑛町的全景地带，能眺望到旭山和十胜山连峰的自然景观，馆内展示着日本已故著名风景摄影家前田真三许多拍摄富良野，美瑛的四季风景作品，光与色的透明表现，令人赞叹。</p> <p>专车续往欣赏美瑛的田园风光，前往位于北海道正中央富良野盆地，特别安排前往富田农场参观，这是北海道风景明信片里，最常出现的地方，除了夏天美丽的彩虹花田，秋冬亦有温室的薰衣草可以欣赏，在广大似海的，延绵不断的丘陵盆地里，是观景的最佳之处。</p> <p>回返札幌。剩余时间，往购物商场，或著名的夜生活精彩场所—薄野。</p>	<p>早餐 午餐</p>

2	<b>Kansai – Universal Studios Japan – Osaka</b> Upon arrival at Kansai Airport, you will be greeted by our representative and transfer to <b>Kobe</b> . Kobe is the capital of Hyogo Prefecture and one of Japan's ten largest cities, located between the sea and the Rokko mountain range, Kobe is also considered one of Japan's most attractive cities. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Chinatown (Nankinmachi):</b> Located in central Kobe, a center of the Chinese community in the Kansai Region. It is a popular tourist attraction as well as a shopping and dining district. Two main streets run through the district, meeting each other at a small plaza in the center. They are packed with shops, restaurants and food stands that sell popular items such as steamed buns (manju), ramen, tapioca drinks and various other Chinese dishes.</li> <li><b>Harbourland (Mosaic Town):</b> The second largest trading port in Japan and is called the Bay Area. It is a popular dating spot that offers many café, restaurants, shops and other amusements.</li> </ul>	<b>Dinner</b>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Nada Sake Brewery Museum:</b> The very hometown of sake breweries. Nada city is famous for sake production due to the availability of high quality of rice and water, the hometown of sake breweries. This museum enriches you with the art and toil of Sake brewing its rich history of Sake brewing. You will also get to sample the all-time-favorite hot alcoholic beverage of the traditional Japanese, Sake.</li> <li>• <b>Universal Studios Japan (optional) – Drop off before KOBE tour and pick up at 1700hrs.</b></li> <li>• Universal Studios Japan, one of four Universal Studios theme parks. There are over 1,200 wild sika deer roaming around in the park freely. You can purchase deer-crackers to feed the deer in the park.</li> <li>• <b>Todaiji Temple</b> is the representative temple of the Nara period and its Daibutsu-den, or Great Buddha's Hall, is the largest wooden structure in the world. The temple is a listed UNESCO World Heritage Site as "Historic Monuments of Ancient Nara".</li> <li>• Proceed to Kyoto which is virtually a living museum of Japan's great artistic heritage. Here, you will get to visit the one of the World Cultural Heritage - <b>Kiyomizu Temple</b>, which occupies the rise of Higashiyama Hill. The main hall, designated as a National Treasure. Jutting out from the hill, its wooden veranda, well known as "the stage of Kiyomizu", is supported a height of 15m by 139 pillars.</li> <li>• After this, you will enjoy '<b>Kimono show</b>' (<b>Japanese fashion show</b>) at the Nishijin Ori Center.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Breakfast</b> <b>Lunch</b> <b>Dinner</b></p>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Next, visit <b>Gotemba Premium Outlet</b>. One of Japan's most popular shopping malls, it is located in Gotemba City at the base of Mount Fuji. The mall features over 200 stores along with a number of restaurants, a food court and a 50-m high ferris wheel.</li> <li>• Tonight, you will stay at hot spring hotel where you may relax and enjoy the hot spring baths!</li> </ul>	
5	<p><b>Lake Kawaguchi – Hananomiyako Flower Field (Ski Field) – Oshino Hakkao 8 Ponds – Tokyo – Shinjuku</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Today, we will visit the <b>Hananomiyako Flower Field</b> (Winter Season mid Dec 2014 to Feb 2015 will replace by Snow Ski field-snow is subject to weather condition,activity at paxs own expense.) that will definitely impress you with its beautiful natural scenery. In spring there are tulips and cosmoses in fall. Mt. Fuji stands in the background of the gardens full of the flowers of the season. Inside the 300,000-m<sup>2</sup> garden that includes these fields of flowers, you'll also find a flower dome where you can view rare tropical plants, and a landscape with a clear stream and waterfalls. Relax in this park full of healing power.</li> <li>• Thereafter proceed to <b>Oshino Hakkai</b>. It is the name given to the 8 ponds filled with melted snow water that has taken more than 80 years to filter through the underground layers of Mt. Fuji. This water is highly-valued and the Japanese referred it as 'sacred water'. The clear water surface reflecting Mt. Fuji that appears to be veiled in an almost mystic air. Not only do these ponds boast fine-quality water, but they harmonize wonderfully with the surrounding rustic scenery, and the water of Oshino Hakkai is ranked among the best-quality waters of Japan.</li> <li>• Return to Tokyo and proceed to visit the famous <b>Asakusa Kannon Temple</b> that has the history of more than 1,300 years. Along <b>Nakamise Street</b>, be charmed by the traditional souvenir shops. Many small shops which sell traditional Japanese items and food line up on both sides of the street, <b>enroute stops at Tokyo Sky Tree (2<sup>nd</sup> world's tallest tower) for photo shooting.</b></li> <li>• Last stop at <b>Shinjuku</b>, one of the 23 wards of Tokyo, but the name commonly refers just to the large entertainment, business and shopping area around Shinjuku Station. There are many big departmental stores around Shinjuku such as Flags, Isetan, Keio, Takashimaya, Lumine and many more.</li> </ul>	Breakfast Lunch
