This is a unique market that is held every day literally on the rail tracks. Just before the train arrivals, the market stallholders have to pull back their awnings and remove their produce from the tracks. They then have to repeat all of this when train returns.(remark: train arrival scheduled is subject to the change without prior notice)</p> <p><b>-Damnoen Saduak Floating Market</b> – One of the most famous floating markets in Thailand. This buzzing market is routinely crowded with hundreds of vendors and purchasers floating in their small rowing boats selling and buying or exchanging their colourful goods, noisy, touristy but great fun.</p> <p><b>-Asiatique The Riverfront</b> - there is an expansive open-air mall with river views and cutting-edge festival market and living museum” concept. Fusing shopping, dining, culture and colonial-style architecture, it offers a pleasant experience for those is search of style and sophistication.</p> <p><b>-Damnoen Saduak Floating Market</b> – One of the most famous floating markets in Thailand. This buzzing market is routinely crowded with hundreds of vendors and purchasers floating in their small rowing boats selling and buying or exchanging their colourful goods, noisy, touristy but great fun.</p> <p><b>- Wat Arun Temple</b> - better known as the Temple of the Dawn, is one of the best known landmarks and one of the most published images of Bangkok.</p> <p><b>-MBK Shopping Mall</b> - founded in 1985, also known as Mah-boon-krong, At 8 stories high and 350 metres long with the total area of 140,000 square meters makes MBK Centre once the biggest mall in Asia.</p> <p><b>HUA HIN</b></p> <p><b>--Swiss Sheep Farm-</b> in place of the ancient dream of those who seek it.Come in contact with the atmosphere of a farm in a valley surrounded by the love that surrounds you with warmth, style European country. Farms that will take you time to dream again.</p> <p><b>-Plearnwan Old town</b> –Thailans’s first eco vintage village.it was built in late 2009 to recapture to recapture the classic charm of old Hua Hin. Plearn means enjoy and wan refers to yesteryear in Thai language. It is described as a “Center of enjoy and happiness”.</p> <p><b>-San Phan Nam Floating Market-</b> in Prachuap Khiri Khan Province is actually a new market, which opened earlier this year. Inspired by the designs of many outstanding landmarks located around Hua Hin, the market’s setting provides a glimpse into the past, while offering tourists the chance to browse among an array of stalls, selling souvenirs and local specialties.</p> <p><b>-Huay Mongkol Temple (Luang Phor Thuad)</b> – This Buddhist temple has the world’s largest statue of Luang Phor Thuad a legendary southern Thai Monk revered for his enlightenment and ability to perform miracles. Many believe that the amulets created in his image guarantee safety in times of distress.</p> <p><b>-Santorini Park</b> – Brings a slice of the picture-perfect Greek Island to Cha-Am. It’s got all the details right, from Classic whitewashed buildings, colorfully painted windows, down to stone-paved paths and domed towers. An impressive line up of shops, restaurants and an amusement park promise good time for.</p> <p><b>-Hua Hin Night Market-</b> is a fascinating insight into Thailand’s way of life. You will find countless outlets and stands selling delicious food which is freshly cooked and served to you within a matter of minutes. Do also take a look behind the stalls on the pavements, because there are plenty of restaurants there as well. #### 观光景点:

##### 曼谷

-**火车市场** -顾名思义就是一列火车会从市场中穿过，一天内总共要经过 8 列。在铁轨的两旁摆满了货摊，琳琅满目，货摊离铁轨也不过 10 厘米的距离，摊主悠然的在这里卖货，当火车警笛拉响时，所有的摊主会瞬间收起货摊，那速度可以用迅雷不及掩耳之势来形容，火车经过后，市场又立刻恢复了刚才的热闹繁忙景象。因为这一特色，火车市场吸引了来自世界各地的游客。

-**丹嫩沙多水上市场** -最有名出镜率最高的水上市场，号称泰文化的“水上主题公园”，有超过 100 年的历史，但现在旅游商业化气息浓重。距市区约 2 小时车程，集市中，一条条船上，劳动妇女们戴著独特的草帽，坐在满载水果、蔬菜和鲜花的小船上，穿梭於狭窄的水道中，大声地吆喝叫卖，小河两岸有栉次鳞比的商店，出售各种特产和精美纪念品，还有一家家临水面而居的水乡居民住宅，构成了一幅令人深感亲切而又典型的曼谷印象图卷。

-**郑皇庙** -是泰国的第一大寺庙，香火鼎盛。郑王庙除了悠久的历史，还以其优雅的建筑风格和精湛的建造工艺闻名于世，成为泰国最为著名的寺庙之一。

-**MBK 购物中心**- MBK 是 Mah Boon Krong 的简称，是曼谷最为本土化的一家综合购物广场。和一般的 Shopping Mall 不同的是，MBK 更像是一个超级大的室内夜市。这里面的店家基本上分成三大类，一是一般性平价店家，商品种类较多，有高知名度连锁品牌，也有不知名的地摊人气货；另一种是无店面式的花车摊位，位在走道的正中央，商品更平价些，从国际名品到本土品牌，价格低廉，人气超旺；最后一种则是完全将跳蚤市场上的商品统统搬到此地，而且价格平价低廉，却仍有讨价还价空间！

-**曼谷最大河岸夜市** - 經過了精心規畫的 Asiatique，落寞的码头改造成一个漂亮的大型夜市，不但保存了码头和仓库旧有的建筑风格以及保留了历史的原貌

并且添加了新颖时尚的设计和规划，给予了这个地方一个全新的生命，再重新設計包裝，搖身一變為集合吃喝玩樂於一身的觀光夜市。

##### 华欣

-**瑞士绵羊牧场**-“华欣特色景点之一”这是一个远离繁华和热闹的好地方，在这里你可以近距离触摸可爱的绵羊，体验喂绵羊吃草，喝奶和了解绵羊的生长过程。

-**才华孟寇寺庙**- (LUANG PHOR TUAD) 这寺庙有世界上最大的 Luang Phor Tuad 雕像，他是一位传奇的泰国南部僧人，人民崇敬他的启蒙和创造奇迹的能力。

-**圣托里尼公园** - 这最新落成的主题式欢乐商场，可以让你错觉仿佛掉入希腊岛屿，因为从经典白墙蓝窗，彩绘窗饰，圆顶塔外，处处都有意想不到的设计惊喜，浓浓的圣托里尼风情，此外还可以找到很多泰国设计的品牌，让你逛得不愿离开。
